



## **Bowl Buster**

### **DESCRIPTION**

Bowl Buster is a concentrated Hydrochloric (9.5%) acid based lavatory cleaner that provides excellent cleaning of rust, scale and lime deposits. Can be used on a variety of surfaces such as tile, porcelain, grout, and stainless steel. Effectively removes water stains and bowl rings. Works well in hard or soft water. Special clinging formula helps clean vertical surfaces.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

It is very important that this product not be used on aluminum. Due to the high acid concentration found in this product, it is important to rinse the outside of these surfaces.

For toilets: Apply directly under rim and sides of toilet and allow 10 minutes contact time for badly soiled surfaces. If used daily apply 1 ounce of product to water and clean with bowl brush for immediate results.

Glazed Urinals: Apply 1 to 2 ounces to urinal surface mixing with water and swab total area. When used properly it will not harm solid porcelain china or vitrious ware.

Shower Stalls: Glazed and ceramic tile and grouting can be cleaned without damage. However, we do recommend that proper dilutions be followed and surfaces rinsed if stronger solutions used.

When cleaning chrome or porcelain enamel dilute no more than 1 part to 4 parts water and allow a short contact time.
