DESCRIPTION

This product is a low foaming carpet shampoo formulated for use with extraction and carpet steam cleaning equipment. This product contains "twin chain" quaternary ammonium compounds to reduce the growth of gram negative and gram positive odor forming bacteria. This product is fortified with odor counteractants to neutralize unpleasant mal odors. Recommended for use on washable synthetic fibers, but not recommended for use on wool carpets. This product removes greasy soil, leaves no residue to promote resoiling, and eliminates soil redeposition to vacuum pick-up tanks.

INSTRUCTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. To clean, sanitize, and deodorize carpets; vacuum carpet before cleaning. Mix two (2) ounces of this product per gallon of water. Inject and extract as you would the other steam cleaning shampoos. For rotary floor machines, mix four (4) ounces of this product per gallon, spray on carpet at a rate of 200-300 square feet per gallon.

NOTE: Test color fastness of carpet before use. Apply diluted cleaner to a small concealed spot, then rub with a clean white cloth. If color transfers to cloth or changes, a water base product should not be used. After cleaning, set carpet pile in one direction with a stiff brush. Place aluminum foil under legs of furniture while carpet is drying. Over-wetting may cause shrinking of carpet. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over-wetting or misuse.

SAFETY
