



TRUCK & PANEL WASH

DESCRIPTION

A high quality panel cleaner for painted trailers used as over the road vehicles. Removes heavy road film and carbon stack stains. Brushing may be necessary but usually is minimal. Do not use on anodized aluminum. Do not use on surfaces protected by new poly sealers. Sealing compound could be damaged or removed. To use for light to medium build-up: use 4 to 6 ounces per gallon of water. For heavy buildup: use 8 ounces per gallon of water.

INSTRUCTIONS

Can be applied with pressure sprayer or pressure washer used at the above dilutions. In either situation it is recommended that any application of this product to be done from the bottom of panel toward the top. If over used and applied in the wrong manner some streaking might occur. These dilutions are offered as normal use levels. In some cases a higher concentration may be necessary but care should be taken to try dilution. Test material in an inconspicuous area to guard against fading.
