



## **GRAFFITI REMOVER**

### **DESCRIPTION**

Graffiti Remover is heavy duty, viscous paint / graffiti remover. Specially designed for use on masonry and concrete surfaces, this product is a slow acting stripper in which the active ingredients penetrate deep through multiple layers of the coating to soften and lift them for easy removal.

Graffiti Remover will not totally dry on the surface and can be left overnight. This product will restore older painted masonry to its original appearance and beauty. It can be applied by brush or by roller, but not with conventional spray equipment. It works best when rinsed with high-pressure equipment allowing the user to flush all paint particles from the surface.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Do not thin prior to use. Scrape loose or peel paint if desired.
2. Using a suitable synthetic brush or roller, apply a heavy coat of stripper in one direction to dry painted surface. When removing multiple layers of paint, a 1/8" to 3/8" build-up of Graffiti Remover will produce optimum results.
3. Allow stripper to remain on the surface for 15 minutes to 16 hours, or until the paint is seen as listed or dissolved.
4. The use of high-pressure rinse water will ensure thorough rinsing and removal of all solubilized paint films and pigmentations from the surface.
5. During removal of multiple coats of paint (in excess of 10), apply a second application of paint stripper on top of the first before commencing the power rinse with high-pressure water. This will improve the efficiency of removal. In most cases, the second application does not need to dwell as long as the original application of stripper.
